Your OSBCC Bargaining Committee has been invited to start meeting with the Ontario Ministry of Education on Tuesday, February 21, 2012 to begin Provincial Discussion Table talks for the 2012 round of bargaining.

Meetings involving the four school board systems are to begin on Tuesday, February 28, 2012.

At the 2012 OSBCC Conference, locals in attendance (representing over 48,000 members), endorsed the following central items for provincial bargaining in 2012:

- No Concessions
- Wages and Benefits
- Job Security
- Scope of Work
- Professional Development
- Employment Equity
- Procurement Policy and CETA

These are the issues that we will start discussing with the Ontario Ministry of Education and the school board system representatives next week.
